



**Christopher Morris** is an Urban Biologist and Senior Environmental Coordinator with the City of Dallas Park and Recreation Department, where he has worked since 2023. As an Urban Biologist for the department, Chris has worked tree plantings and canopy assessments; addressed the Emerald Ash Borer threat, worked pollinator programs for gardening, coordinated Master Naturalist/Gardener service projects, provided wildlife education for species such as coyotes and eagles; and conducted invasive vegetation removals and alternative vegetation management, such as the goat project.

Prior to joining the department, Chris worked in the Office of Environmental Quality and Sustainability in Air Quality, Water Quality and Green Spaces for the Comprehensive Environmental Climate Action Plan. He was also the Regional and Municipal Coordinator for the Texas Stream Team from 2012 to 2022 for the City of Dallas and North Central Texas Council of Governments, bringing water quality education and programming to Citizen/Community Scientists.
