

**Canaan Sutton** is a botanist for the southern plains region of the National Ecological Observatory Network (NEON). He graduated from East Texas A&M University and conducted graduate research on prairie restoration methods, working in constructed wetlands and also Clymer Meadow preserve. He has conducted forest structure research for the NASA jet propulsion laboratory, plant diversity and phenology surveys at the LBJ grasslands and rolling red plains in western Oklahoma and is currently working with the Arkansas Natural Heritage Commission on describing Composite species in the Ouachita mountains. Canaan also served as the past president of the Blackland Chapter of the Native Prairies Association of Texas (NPAT), from 2022-2024.
